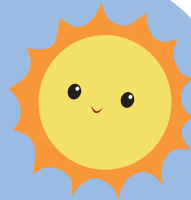




# Curriculum Bytes



## Water

1. Fill two cups with soil and set them next to each other on a windowsill.
2. Plant two or three of the same vegetable seeds in each.
3. Water one with fresh water and the other with salt water. (Add table salt to water and stir.)
4. See which one grows.
